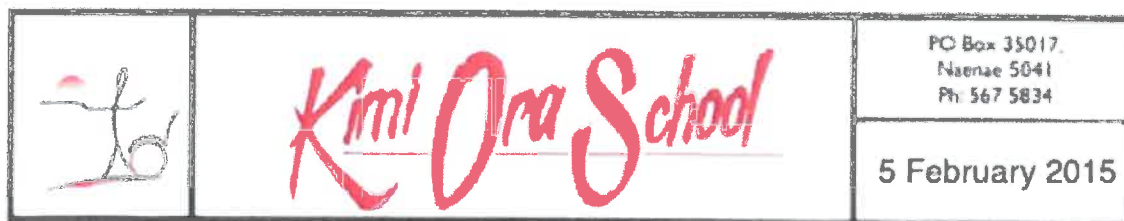

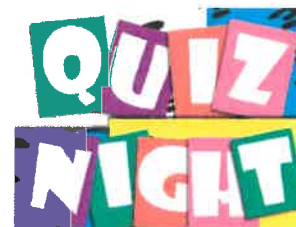


Piwakawaka Class (Room 2 Naenae) went bowling at the end of last year. Not only was it a fun trip it was also a great experience for doing some practical maths.
