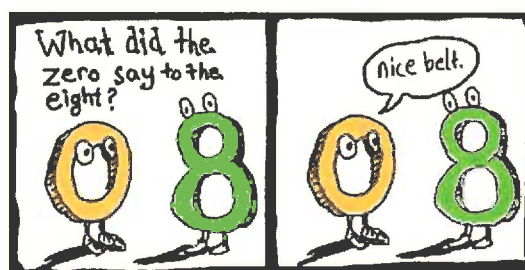
Nikki has been flown to Auckland, with Life Flight, to the burns unit at Middlemore Hospital.
