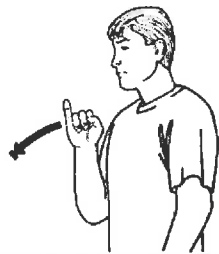


Kimi News, Week 2, Term 2, 2015
