

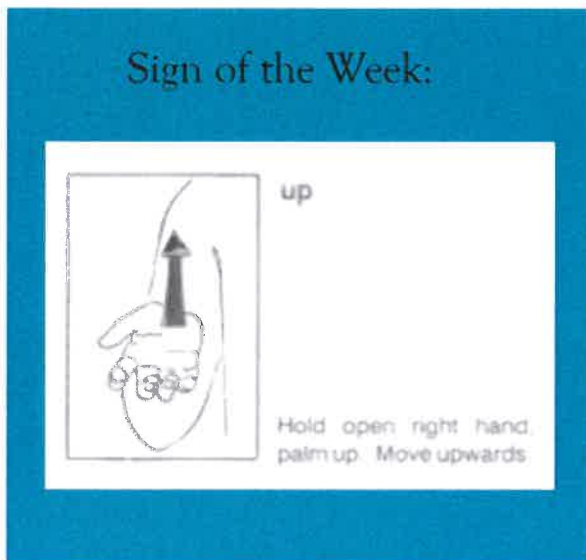
At Kimi Ora School we pride ourselves in being a resource school for other special educators. Part of that includes offering professional development opportunities for the greater Wellington area.
