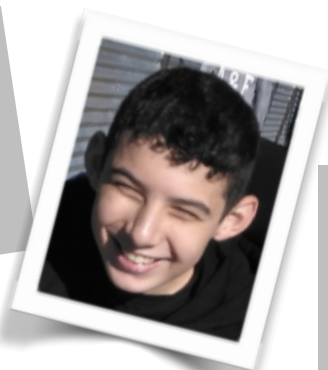


If you are able to help with the Quiz Night it would be greatly appreciated!
