This Term we have had a change of taxi company for our Naenae students. We had a lovely farewell at the end of Term Two for drivers who have chaffered our students for many years.

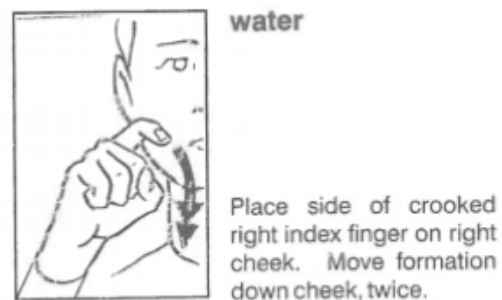
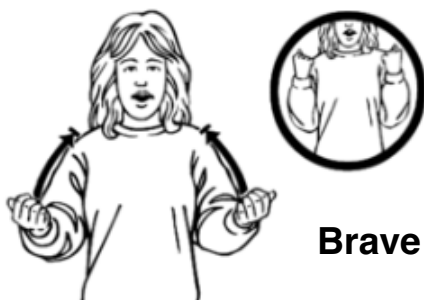
Cross Country Rentals have been transporting students this Term. They are a neat group of drivers who have the challenge of getting to know all of the students' individual needs and preferences.

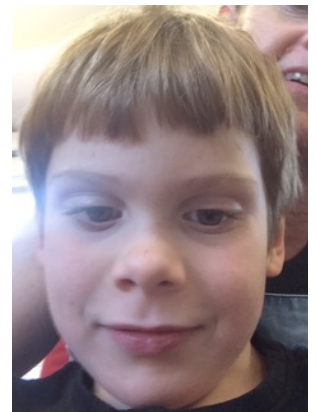

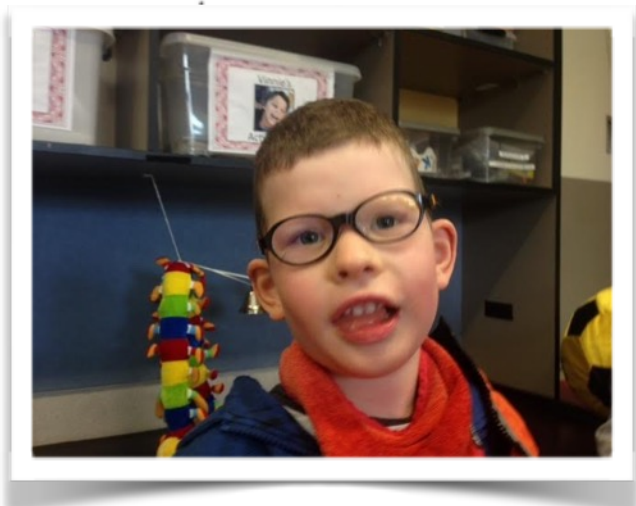
