

Kimi News, Week 4, Term 4, 2016

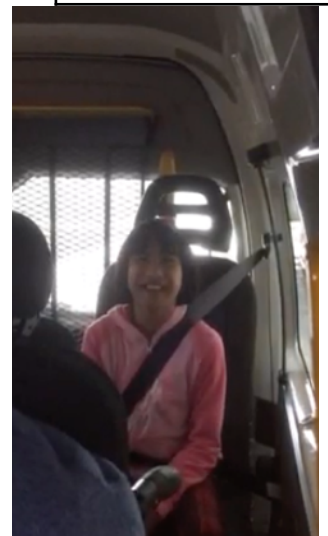

Staff who are keen to drive the van have had training in how to safely secure wheelchairs, and have been for a test drive with our resident driving instructor Dave Speden (Occupational Therapist Extraordinaire)!

The first students to travel in the van were Kahu Class. They were so excited! The van is being well used including regular trips to RDA (Riding for the Disabled), social communication outings, Kapa Haka and Playground Group. There have also been some one off trips such as a recent trip to Rongotai College to watch a rehearsal of their end of year show.

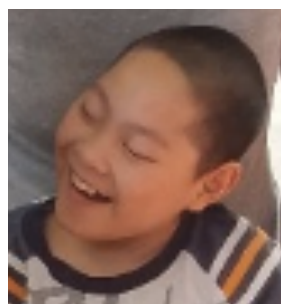

Lions Club of Wellington Host 'WORLD FESTIVAL OF MAGIC' (2016)

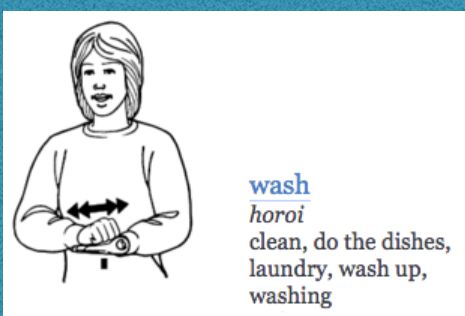

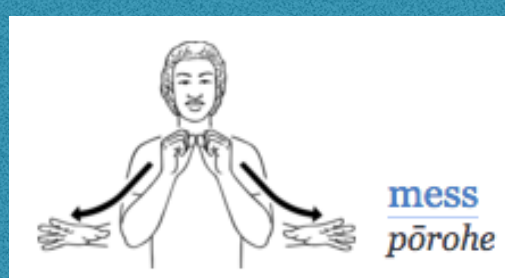
