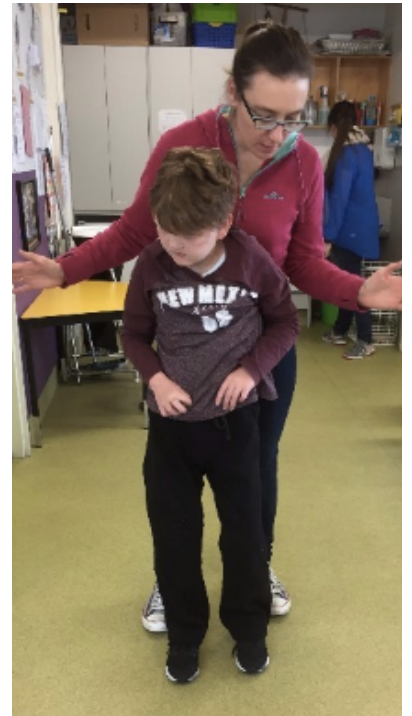

Check out all the amazing MOVE work that has been going on! We have been celebrating all the awesomely strong standing that students have been doing!

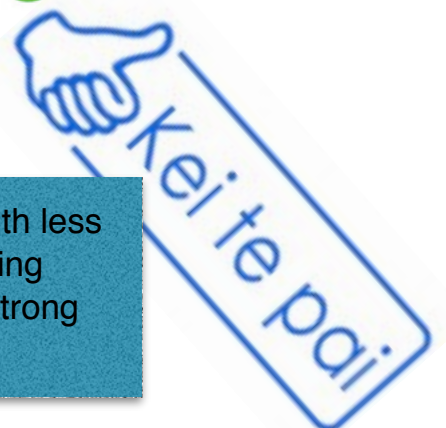

A Christmas Pop up is planning to visit the Walter Nash Centre garden at 6pm on Tuesday 6 December.

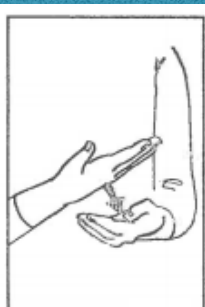
